




### WHY DIAMOND OPEN ACCESS




- An equitable model of scholarly communication where authors and readers are not charged fees for publishing or reading
- Community-owned: scholarly communities
   own and control all content-related elements of
   scholarly publishing
- Engages the scholarly community in all aspects
  of the creation and ownership of contentrelated elements, from journals and platform,
  publications, reviews, preprints, decisions,
  data, and correspondence to reviewer



# HOW DO YOU PERFORM YOUR SELF-ASSESSMENT?

### REGISTER

To take the self-assessment test you must be registered on the platform. To register, press the top "ENTER" button and then click on "REGISTER NOW" to create your account.





### LOGIN

To enter, click on the top button "ENTER" and enter your username and password, if you are not registered, click on "REGISTER NOW" and create your account.



The platform has two modules to complete the self-assessment test, DOAS and Sustainability. You can complete one or both tests.



### **AUTOEVALUATE**

When you select one of the modules, a quiz will appear.
Answer the questions until you complete it. When
you're done, click the "FINISH" button to finish the test
and send it to your email.



When you finish the test, you will receive a full report with the results in your email. Remember, you can take it again or complete the next test, for this, you must go back to step 1.


